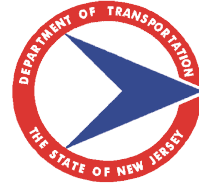

**SUBJECT: Warm Mix Asphalt (WMA) Additives and Processes**  
**- Revision to Subpart 902.01.04 of the 2019 Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction.**

Subpart 902.01.04 of the 2019 Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction has been revised as NEAUPG will no longer approve new WMA products effective January 1, 2025 as noted on their website [Welcome to the NEAUPG Website | North East Asphalt User/Producer Group](#)). In lieu of NEAUPG approval, a new Materials Approval Process (MAP) for WMA products has been developed and will be available at the Bureau of Materials website ([NJDOT Qualified Materials, Engineering](#)).

**The following revision has been incorporated into the 2019 Standard Specifications via the 2019 Standard Inputs, SI2019:**


**902.01.04 Warm Mix Asphalt (WMA) Additives and Processes**  
THE FIRST PARAGRAPH IS CHANGED TO:

Use a WMA additive or process that is listed on the QPL.

### **Implementation Code R (ROUTINE)**


Changes must be implemented in all applicable Department projects scheduled for Final Design Submission at least one month after the date of the BDC announcement. This will allow designers to make necessary plan, specifications, and estimate/proposal changes without requiring the need for addenda or postponement of advertisement or receipt of bids.
