Route 4 eastbound ramp to Route 17 northbound overnight closure required in preparation of electrical work in Paramus Signed detour will be in place overnight

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced overnight closures on the Route 4 eastbound ramp to Route 17 northbound as an electrical project advances in Paramus, Bergen County.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Friday, March 19, until 5 a.m. tomorrow, Saturday, March 20, NJDOT's contractor, Orchard Holdings, is scheduled to close the ramp from Route 4 eastbound to Route 17 northbound. This closure will allow the contractor to place equipment behind the guiderail in preparation for replacement of the light tower. The following signed detour will be in place overnight:

Route 4 eastbound ramp to Route 17 northbound detour:

- Motorists traveling on Route 4 eastbound wishing to take the ramp to Route 17 northbound will be directed to continue on Route 4 eastbound
- Keep right and take exit to Spring Valley Road
- Stay in the left lane and turn left onto Spring Valley Road before the CVS Pharmacy
- Cross over Route 4 and at the stop sign turn left towards Route 4 west/Paterson
- Merge onto Route 4 westbound
- Keep right and take exit to Route 17 north/Mahwah

As the project progresses, additional overnight ramp closures with detours will be required. Notification will be provided in advance of traffic pattern changes.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
