Route 1&9 Truck northbound lane closures this weekend to repair the Passaic River Bridge between Kearny & Newark At least one lane of northbound traffic will be maintained

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced a right lane closure on Route 1&9 Truck northbound between Newark and Kearny this weekend as repairs to the bridge across the Passaic River continue.

Beginning at 8 p.m. tonight, Friday, May 21 until 8 p.m. Sunday, May 23, NJDOT's contractor, I.E.W. Construction Group, is scheduled to close the right lane on Route 1&9 Truck northbound between Doremus Avenue in Newark and Jacobus Avenue in Kearny. This closure will allow the contractor to install barrier sliding plates on the Bridge over the Passaic River. At least one lane of northbound traffic will be maintained throughout the weekend.
