I-80 eastbound lane and ramp closures tonight and tomorrow night in Parsippany-Troy Hills and Fairfield Closures required for pavement preservation project

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced lane and ramp closures on I-80 eastbound tonight and tomorrow night in Parsippany-Troy Hills and Fairfield as pavement preservation work continues in Morris and Essex counties.

Tonight, Friday, June 24

Beginning at 8 p.m., tonight, Friday, June 24, until 6 a.m., Saturday, June 25, NJDOT's contractor, Schifano Construction Corp., is scheduled to close two lanes on I-80 eastbound between approximately milepost 47 and milepost 53. In addition, between 11 p.m. tonight, Friday, June 24, until 4 a.m., Saturday, June 25, the ramp from Two Bridges Road to I-80 eastbound will be closed and detoured. The closure is necessary for paving and applying high performance thin overlay. The following detour will be in place:

Two Bridges Road ramp to I-80 eastbound:

- Motorists on Two Bridges Road wishing to take the on-ramp to I-80 eastbound will be directed to continue on Two Bridges Road
- Take the ramp onto Route 46 eastbound
- Take the exit for Route 23 North to I-80/Service Road
- Continue on Route 23 northbound
- Take the exit to I-80 East/New York

Tomorrow, Saturday, June 25

Beginning at 11 p.m., tomorrow, Saturday, June 25, until 4 a.m., Sunday, June 26, the Route 46 eastbound ramp to I-80 eastbound is scheduled to be closed and detoured. The closure is necessary for striping and the installation of reflective roadway pavement markers. The following detour will be in place Saturday night:

Route 46 eastbound ramp to I-80 eastbound detour:

- Motorists on Route 46 eastbound wishing to take the ramp to I-80 eastbound will be directed to continue on Route 46 eastbound
- Take the ramp to I-80 eastbound/Hook Mountain Road
- Turn right onto Chapin Road
- Stay right to continue on Chapin Road, which becomes Hook Mountain Road
- Turn right onto New Maple Avenue
- Stay left to take the ramp from New Maple Avenue to I-80 eastbound

The work is part of the \$5.5 million federally-funded I-80, Beverwyck Road (CR 637) to Route 23 pavement preservation project to make repairs at various locations in Morris, Essex, and Passaic counties. The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
