Route 29 southbound ramp to Route 1 southbound to be closed tonight for electrical work in Trenton, Mercer County Traffic will be detoured overnight on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday

(Trenton) – The Route 29 southbound ramp to Route 1 southbound will be closed and detoured from 8 p.m. tonight, Tuesday, September 13 until 4 a.m. Wednesday, September 14, and again on Wednesday and Thursday nights at the same time, in Trenton, Mercer County.

The ramp closures are necessary for the installation of new lighting poles on the parapet wall.

Motorists on Route 29 southbound wishing to take the ramp to Route 1 southbound will be directed to take the Cass Street exit and follow the posted detour.

This work is part of a \$1.5 million state-funded Traffic Signal Relamping contract for electrical work in various locations throughout Atlantic, Burlington, Camden, Cape May, Cumberland, Gloucester, Mercer, Monmouth, Ocean & Salem counties.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
