Route 4 westbound two right lanes to be closed overnight Saturday in Teaneck, Bergen County Closure necessary to place construction barrier

(Trenton) – Route 4 westbound is scheduled to have the two right lanes closed on Saturday night just past the Garrison Avenue/Sussex Road Overpass in Teaneck, Bergen County.

Beginning at 11 p.m. tomorrow, Saturday, September 16, until 8 a.m. Sunday, September 17, the right and center lanes on Route 4 westbound are scheduled to be closed to place construction barrier between Garrison Avenue/Sussex Road and Wilson Avenue. At least one lane will be maintained during construction. Motorists are advised to slow down, use caution, and expect delays.

By 8 a.m. Sunday, September 17, the center lane will be reopened to traffic, and the right lane will remain closed. The closure is necessary for drainage installation and is expected to remain in place for approximately one month.

The work is part of a \$15.8 million state-funded maintenance project to repair stormwater facilities at various locations in eight counties throughout North Jersey.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
