Route 17 southbound to be closed and detoured this weekend in Wood-Ridge, Bergen County Closure necessary for drainage repairs

(Trenton) – Route 17 southbound is scheduled to be closed this weekend at Moonachie Avenue in Wood-Ridge, Bergen County. This work was originally scheduled for Friday, October 6 but was postponed due to weather.

Beginning at 8 p.m. Friday, November 10 until 11:59 p.m. Sunday, November 12, Route 17 southbound is scheduled to be closed and detoured at Moonachie Avenue for drainage repairs on Route 17 underneath the Moonachie Avenue overpass. The following detour will be in place:

Route 17 southbound detour:

- Motorists on Route 17 southbound will be directed to take the ramp to Wood-Ridge/Moonachie
- Cross Moonachie Avenue to take the ramp onto Route 17 southbound

The work is part of a \$15.8 million state-funded maintenance contract to repair stormwater facilities at various locations in eight counties throughout North Jersey.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
