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Route 15 southbound to be closed this afternoon as bridge replacement project advances in Jefferson Township, Morris County Traffic to be detoured during construction

(Trenton) – Route 15 southbound is scheduled to be closed and detoured beginning this afternoon as the Bridge over Rockaway River replacement project advances in Jefferson Township, Morris County.

This afternoon, Tuesday, June 4, Route 15 southbound is scheduled to be closed on the Bridge over Rockaway River. The following detour will be in place:

Route 15 southbound Bridge over Rockaway River Detour:

- Motorists on Route 15 southbound wishing to take the bridge over Rockaway River will be directed
 to take the ramp to Edison Road/Lake Hopatcong/Mount Arlington/U and Left Turns, which is
 approximately two miles north of the bridge
- Continue on Edison Road/CR 615
- Turn left onto Espanong Road/CR 615, which becomes Minnisink Road
- Turn left onto Berkshire Valley Road
- Take the ramp for Route 15 southbound

The \$11.6 million project will replace the Route 15 southbound Bridge over the Rockaway River. The new bridge will be a single-span concrete box beam structure with two 12-foot-wide travel lanes, 10-foot-wide inside and outside shoulders, and sidewalks on both sides of the bridge. The new bridge will improve the roadway geometry and improve sight distance. The project will advance in stages to ease impact on motorists. NJDOT will provide advance notice of any lane or ramp closures.
