Route 47 closure and detour starts Monday for drainage work in Maurice River Township, Cumberland County Detour expected to be in place for approximately six weeks

(Trenton) – Route 47 is scheduled to be closed and detoured in both directions between Main Street and Hunters Mill Road starting Monday as a drainage project begins in Maurice River Township, Cumberland County.

Starting at 7 a.m. on Monday, June 10, Route 47 is scheduled to be closed in both directions between Main Street and Hunters Mill Road. The closure is necessary for a drainage project that will replace two culverts on Route 47 over Little Mill Creek. Motorists will be directed to use Main Street/CR 616 and Hunters Mill Road as a detour.

The work is part of a \$7.7 million state-funded maintenance contract that will make drainage repairs in various locations in Atlantic, Burlington, Camden, Cape May, Cumberland, Gloucester and Salem counties.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
