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Route 46 westbound lane closures for emergency drainage pipe repair in Ridgefield Park, Bergen County **At least two lanes will be maintained**

(Trenton) – The two right lanes on Route 46 westbound are closed for emergency drainage repairs before the Bridge over Overpeck Creek near the exit for the New Jersey Turnpike and I-80 westbound in Ridgefield Park, Bergen County.

At approximately 3:30 p.m. today, Monday, June 17, the two right lanes on Route 46 westbound were closed between Route 93/Grand Avenue and the Bridge over Overpeck Creek in Ridgefield Park for emergency drainage pipe replacement. The two left lanes remain open and the exit to the New Jersey Turnpike South/I-80 West/Teaneck Road remains open.

Crews are in the process of replacing a collapsed pipe. Later tonight, there will be a temporary closure of Route 46 westbound to reopen the two right lanes and close the two left lanes. At least two lanes will be maintained. Work is expected to continue through the Tuesday morning commute and be completed later in the morning. Motorists are advised to slow down, use caution, and expect delays in the morning.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
