GMO's Top Picks:

Undocumented Orphaned Well Characterization and Remediation

Funding Agency: Department of Energy

Purpose: To develop advanced tools and technologies that will significantly reduce methane emissions and other environmental impacts associated with undocumented orphaned wells.

Eligibility: State, city, township, Native American, and county governments, public, state, and private institutions of higher education, small businesses, Native American tribal organizations, nonprofits with/without 501(c)(3), for profits.

Funding: \$15,000,000; awards up to \$3,400,000

Deadline: 11/13/24

National Rural Transit Assistance Program

Funding Agency: Department of Transportation

Purpose: To carry out activities to design and implement training and technical assistance projects and other support services tailored to meet the specific needs of transit operators in rural areas, including tribal transit services.

Eligibility: Nonprofits with a 501(c)(3) **Funding:** awards up to \$3,250,723

Deadline: 11/12/24

Solid Waste Infrastructure for Recycling Grants for Political Subdivisions of States and Territories

Funding Agency: Environmental Protection Agency

Purpose: To assist local waste management authorities by supporting improvements to local post-consumer materials management, including municipal recycling programs, and assisting local waste management authorities in making improvements to local waste management systems.

Eligibility: Others (see eligibility on NOFO)
Funding: \$58,000,000; awards up to \$5,000,000
Deadline: 12/20/24

Department of Energy Announces \$90 Million to Accelerate Building Code Adoption and Save Americans Money

September 16, 2024 - The Department of Energy announced \$90 million in competitive awards to help states, cities, and tribal nations, and their partners implement updated energy codes for residential and commercial buildings. Rutgers University was awarded \$3.2 million. They will undertake key market priming activities, including policy research and analysis, demonstration and evaluation of performance-based standards, stakeholder engagement and workforce development and training.
