POST THIS PERS-STATE MEMBER NOTICE IN A PUBLIC AREA AT THE WORKPLACE

- At its meeting on January 15, 2025, the Board of Trustees (Board) of the Public Employees' Retirement System (PERS), deemed Thomas Bruno elected to a three-year term as State Representative to the PERS Board, effective July 1, 2025.
- Mr. Bruno was the only candidate to obtain 500 or more eligible PERS-State member nominations online or by paper petition. Therefore, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:2-1.4, the PERS Board noted that Mr. Bruno is elected to the State Representative position without balloting.
- Mr. Bruno is retired from the Hunterdon Developmental Center. This is his seventh three-year term as a representative on the PERS Board. Mr. Bruno also serves as Chairperson on the PERS Board.
- Notices for the next election cycle will be distributed through employers in the Fall of 2025, which will provide interested candidates with instructions for obtaining nominating information.
