- The Board of Trustees of the Public Employees' Retirement System (PERS) during its meeting on January 18, 2017, deemed Brian Currie elected to a three-year term as Municipal Representative to the PERS Board, effective July 1, 2017.
- Mr. Currie was the only candidate to obtain 500 or more eligible PERS Municipal member nominations on-line or by paper petition. Therefore, in accordance with <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 17:2-1.4, the PERS Board noted that Mr. Currie is elected to the Municipal Representative position without balloting.
- Mr. Currie is employed by the Buena Regional School District in a PERScovered position. Mr. Currie has served as a Municipal Representative on the PERS Board since July 1, 2014.
