SUBJECT: Proof of Insurability For Employees Age 60 and Over

This email message serves as a reminder to employers that Public Employees Retirement System (PERS) and Teachers' Pension and Annuity Fund (TPAF) members age 60 or older hired on or after May 21, 2010, and members of the Defined Contribution Retirement Program (DCRP) and the Alternate Benefits Program (ABP), must provide satisfactory evidence of insurability in order to be to enroll Group Life Insurance coverage and apply for long-term disability insurance coverage if eligible.

Members age 60 and older will receive a letter from the NJDPB upon receipt of their application or enrollment in the PERS, TPAF, DCRP, or ABP indicating they must complete a medical underwriting form and return it to Prudential within 12 months of the date of the letter or future coverage will be prohibited.
