1 WHEREAS, By a resolution in Congress entitled "Joint resolution proposing  
2 an amendment to the Constitution of the United States relating to the  
3 qualifications of electors," passed during the second session of the  
4 Eighty-Seventh Congress of the United States, the following article was  
5 proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of the United States:

### "ARTICLE

6 "Section 1. The right of citizens of the United States to vote in any  
7 primary or other election for President or Vice-President, for electors for  
8 President or Vice-President, or for Senator or Representative in Congress,  
9 shall not be denied or abridged by the United States or any State by reason  
10 of failure to pay any poll tax or other tax.

11 "Sec. 2. The Congress shall have power to enforce this article by ap-  
12 propriate legislation."
