A Concurrent Resolution ratifying proposed amendment to the Constitution of the United States, relating to the qualifications of electors.

- 1 Whereas, By a resolution in Congress entitled "Joint resolution proposing
- an amendment to the Constitution of the United States relating to the

- 4 Eighty-Seventh Congress of the United States, the following article was
- 5 proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of the United States:

"ABTICLE

- 6 "Section 1. The right of citizens of the United States to vote in any
- 7 primary or other election for President or Vice-President, for electors for
- 8 President or Vice-President, or for Senator or Representative in Congress,
- 9 shall not be denied or abridged by the United States or any State by reason
- 10 of failure to pay any poll tax or other tax.
- "Sec. 2. The Congress shall have power to enforce this article by ap-
