2023 Public Health AmeriCorps Notice of Funding Opportunity

The NJ Commission on National and Community Service, NJ Department of State, announces funding opportunities for 2023 AmeriCorps Public Health AmeriCorps grants. AmeriCorps is a federally-funded national service program. Through this Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO), the NJ Commission seeks to identify evidence-based program models. Projects will deploy a cadre of AmeriCorps participants to solve significant community problems. In return for their service, participants benefit from a living allowance of starting at **\$17,600** (F/T) and an educational award for college attendance or to pay back existing federal loans (about \$6,495 for F/T service). This is a two-year grant; no cost share or match required; maximum MSY \$28,800.

This competition invites applications that address the AmeriCorps and NJ's State Service Plan within the priority areas of: Helping local communities respond to and recover from the COVID-19 pandemic; Creating pathways to good-quality public health-related careers through on-site experience and training; Serving in communities with concentrated poverty, rural communities, tribal communities, and those organizations serving historically underrepresented and under-served individuals. Eligible agencies include Indian Tribes; institutions of higher education; local governments; public health departments; nonprofit organizations; state service commissions; states and US territories.

Applications are due to the Commission online via [eGrants](#) on **Thursday, November 17, 2022**.

Virtual attendance (live or recorded viewing) at both the General Technical assistance session and the Theory of Change sessions are required in order to be considered for funding.
