N.J.S.A. 19:61-9: AUDITS OF ELECTION RESULTS

2022 General Election

Audit Date: November 29, 2022

The Atlantic County Board of Elections (BOE herein) performed an audit consistent with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:61-9 and the New Jersey Election Audit Procedures developed by the New Jersey State Division of Elections.

The Atlantic County BOE conducted a hand-to-eye count of the voter-verifiable paper records for the General Election for all federal offices, as well as county and municipal offices selected by the Secretary of State. The Federal office to be audited is that of the United States House of Representatives. In addition, a municipal wide office must be included such as city council, common council, township committee, etc. As directed by the Division of Elections and Secretary of State Tahesha Way, the Board Commissioners could choose a countywide office and the only countywide office is County Commissioner at Large. All other offices and public questions were excluded from the audit.

Each Congressional District must be audited separately from the next. The County of Atlantic contains only 1 such district. Pursuant to the statute, "the audit shall be conducted in at least 2% of the election districts." Further, under the guidelines, if a legislative district has fewer than 100 units then at least 2 units must be audited from that district. At present, Atlantic County contains 151 election districts.


The table below indicates how the number of audit units were calculated:




$$561 \times 2\% = 11 \text{ Batches/Units}$$
