N.J.S.A. 19:61-9: AUDITS OF ELECTION RESULTS

2022 General Election

Audit Date: November 29, 2022

The Cumberland County Board of Elections (BOE herein) performed an audit consistent with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:61-9 and the New Jersey Election Audit Procedures developed by the New Jersey State Division of Elections (See attached).

The Cumberland County BOE conducted a hand-to-eye count of the voter-verifiable paper records for the General Election for all state offices, legislative district offices as well as county and municipal offices selected by the Secretary of State. The offices to be audited are that of the U.S. House of Representative, Board of County Commissioners, City Commissioner, and Township Committee as directed by the Division of Elections and Secretary of State Tahesha Way. All other offices were excluded from the audit.

Pursuant to the statute, "the audit shall be conducted in at least 2% of the election districts."

There were 486 audit units for the County of Cumberland. Two percent (2%) of 486 batches indicated that ten (10) batches were required to be audited. A total of ten (10) batches were audited.

The following audit units were randomly selected:

- 1. TUB 4 Batch 147 Upper Deerfield Township District 2
- 2. TUB 4 Batch 149 Stow Creek Township
- 3. RED BAG UPD-1 Upper Deerfield Township District 1
- 4. TUB 6 Batch 356 Upper Deerfield Township District 3
- 5. RED BAG HW-2 Hopewell Township District 2
- 6. RED BAG VLD 5-6 City of Vineland Ward 5 District 6
- 7. TUB 4 Batch 131 Downe Township District 2
- 8. TUB 4 Batch 155 City of Millville Ward 3 District 2
- 9. RED BAG UPD-3 Upper Deerfield Township District 3
- 10. TUB 4 Batch 137 Greenwich Township

In each district, the hand to eye audit was 100% consistent with the scanned tally. Any paper ballot which contained an overvote for a particular contest was recorded as an overvote but did not count as a vote.
