N.J.S.A 19:61-9 AUDITS OF ELECTION RESULTS 2022 General Election

Audit Date: November 28, 2022

The Morris County Board of Elections performed an audit consistent with the provisions of N.J.S.A 19:61-9.

The General Election held on November 8, 2022 was conducted using the ES&S Express Vote XL ballot marking device voting machine at the polls on Election Day and during the (9) days of Early Voting. The Vote-By-Mail and Provisional Ballots were also part of the audit.

Morris County is comprised of (2) Congressional Districts. Pursuant to the statute, based on the number of election districts in each Congressional District a random selection of 2% or at least (2) units/batches of all voting machines and paper ballot units/batches for each Congressional District were audited.

The following audit units were randomly selected:

In each unit/batch, the hand to eye audit was consistent with the scanned tally report except for East Hanover where a voter used white-out on their mail-in ballot switching from one candidate to the other resulting in a one vote difference. Then in Jefferson, the voter marked their selections with a check mark which did not fill enough of the oval. The audit did not tally under-votes.
