N.J.S.A. 19:61-9: AUDIT OF ELECTION RESULTS 2024 GENERAL ELECTION AUDIT DATE: Tuesday, November 19, 2024

On Tuesday, November 19, 2024, the Bergen County Board of Elections conducted an audit consistent with the provisions of N.J.S.A 19:61-9. The board conducted a hand count of a random sampling of the Early Voting, Provisional, Mail-in and election day voting paper ballots.

The total number of ballots cast with paper records was 463,837. The contest audited were:

- 1. U.S. President
- 2. U.S. Senate
- 3. U.S. House of Representatives
- 4. County-wide Office
- 5. Top Local Contest Council/Committee

Participating in the audit were 2 Board of Election Commissioners and 6 BOE office staff. As required, we did 2% of the 562 Bergen County election districts totaling 1428 ballots. The random batches are listed below.

Englewood Cliffs - 891 - ICC Provisional Tabulator 3 Batch 17

Bergenfield - 886 - ICC Mail-in Tabulator 4 Batch 243

Glen Rock - Coleman School - 393 ICP Scanner 1

All hand tallies matched the machine counts except 1) ICP Scanner 2 Wyckoff calculated one more vote for Donald Trump and one more vote for Kamala Harris and one less vote calculated for Curtis Bashaw and one less vote for Robert Kuglar, possibly due to an error in the adjudication process. 2) Batch 86 Tabulator 6 Hasbrouck Heights, the machine counted one less vote for Mary Blanusa and Kim Sealy, possibly as a result of an error during adjudication (i.e. marks unidentifiable, etc..)

This results in a 99.9% accuracy rate for the election.
