

Because of the change, the municipal tax levy shown in column 12C1A reflects a tax levy used to calculate the municipal tax rate for the calendar year tax billing cycle. The final municipal budget amount to be raised by taxes is set in the adopted fiscal year budget. Shown below is the amount for the 2014 - 2015 fiscal year.
